

BARRON FIELD

Barron Field was one of three flying training fields around Fort Worth during World War I built by the US Army. Located near Everman, south of Fort Worth, it was first known as Camp Taliaferro Number 2. The field was one square mile in size and was used by Royal Flying Corps Canada and the US Army. At the north end of the field was the camp and 19 airplane hangars. A concrete munitions building remains at Oak Grove Road, south of Everman Parkway, and a Texas Historical Marker is located at the site. The site served as Fort Worth's first civil airport.
