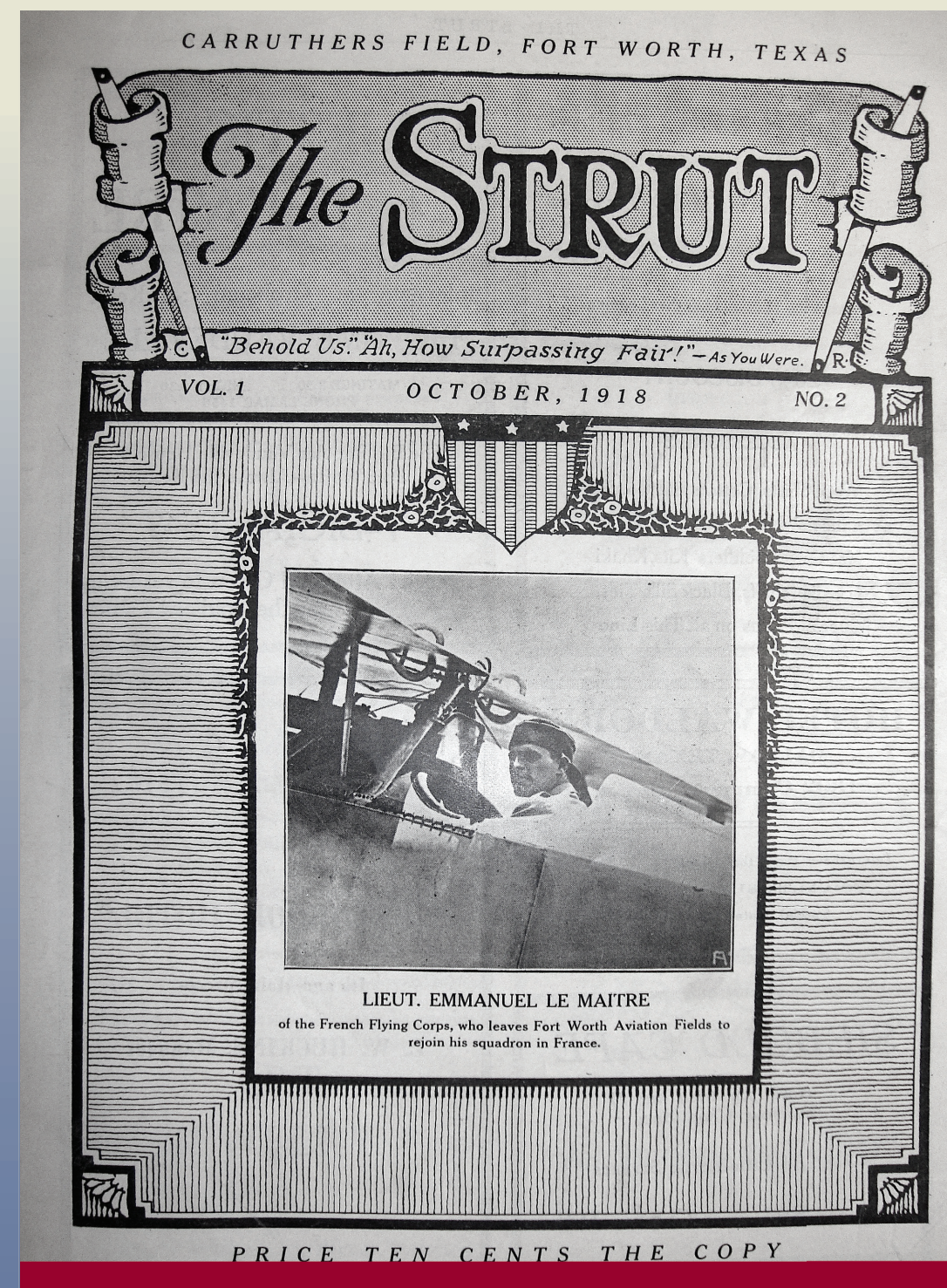


# CARRUTHERS FIELD

Carruthers Field was one of three flying training fields around Fort Worth built by the US Army during World War I. Located in Benbrook, it was originally known as Taliaferro Field Number 3. The field was one square mile in size and was used by Royal Flying Corps Canada and the US Army. At the north end of the field was the camp and 16 airplane hangars. The site is now covered mostly by houses and a school. The field was used by Royal Flying Corps Canada for training between November 1917 and April 1918.
